Program Statement

Introduction

Lawson Manor, a Community Based Residential Facility (CBRF), is owned and operated by United Pioneer Home, Inc. Lawson Manor is an essential part of the continuum of care located on the United Pioneer Home campus at 625 South Second Street in Luck, Wisconsin.

Our facility is designed to enhance your independence and quality of life. There is qualified staff on-site 24 hours a day. A registered nurse (RN) consultant coordinates Resident cares and ongoing training for the caregivers; the RN is available on call 24 hours a day. The manager or their designee will also be available 24 hours a day.

Our Facility

Lawson Manor is located on the United Pioneer Home campus, with several services provided by United Pioneer Home. There is a private entrance and separation between the CBRF and nursing home.

Below are some facts about Lawson Manor:

Size: Lawson Manor is licensed for 16 Residents.

Facility Classification: Class CNA, this means our facility may serve Residents who are ambulatory, semi-ambulatory or non-ambulatory, but one or more of whom are not physically or mentally capable of responding to an electronic fire alarm and exiting the facility without help or verbal or physical prompting.

Admission and Retention Limitations: The following conditions or care needs **cannot** be provided at Lawson Manor:

- Medically unstable condition (ex. Frequent and complex changes in medical condition or sliding scale insulin).
- The Resident's medical health must be stable and predictable and medical orders must not involve frequent or complex changes.
- Unmanageable incontinence.
- A strictly monitored specialized diet (ex. diabetic, low sodium, high calorie).
- A need for more than three (3) hours of licensed nursing care per week.
- Diagnosis of a communicable disease.
- Two (2) person transfers.
- History of unsafe wandering or elopement.
- Physical restraints.
- Physically or mentally abusive to other Residents, staff, or visitors or are destructive to themselves or property.
- Inability to be evacuated from the facility within four (4) minutes should the need occur.

Resident Group Served: Lawson Manor will serve those who are elderly, age 62 or older, and are in need of some assistance and supervision with activities of daily living (ADLs) and/or medication management and administration. Lawson Manor can care for Residents who need assistance with walking, assistive devices such as canes, walkers, and wheelchairs are welcome.

Our Services and Goals

Lawson Manor's services include:

- The manager, registered nurse consultant and caregivers will provide health monitoring, assessments and care planning.
- Registered nurse consultant on-call 24 hours a day.
- Medication management and administration assistance if needed.
- Assistance with tub baths and/or showers if needed.
- Call system for easy access to caregiver staff 24 hours a day.
- Assistance with activities of daily living (ADLs), including assistance with dressing, grooming, and toileting.
- On-site physical, occupational, and speech therapy.
- On site dental, eye, audiology, and podiatry exams.
- In-house doctor visits if required and provided by your personal doctor.
- Hospice services are available.
- Organization of medical appointments and transportation.
- Pharmacy services.
- On-site barber and beautician services.
- Daily activity programming.
- Cable television (basic cable free), Wi-Fi, and telephone services.
- Several common spaces perfect for visiting with friends and family or just to relax, including a wellness room and an interior courtyard.

Most of these services offered are included in your fees, but some are billed by a third party. Please see the admission agreement packet for more information.
